



Announcement of Pathumthani Immigration

Subject: Declaration of Intent to Prevent Corruption (No Gift Policy), B.E.2569 (2026)

Pathumthani Immigration hereby declares its intention to establish standards of transparency and accountability for actions undertaken, with the aim of building an organization free from corruption in the performance of official duties. The Office upholds a culture of integrity and prioritizes public interest, fostering professional advancement based on merit and duty rather than personal relationships. This declaration serves as a guideline for official conduct and as an organizational value to be adhered to in conjunction with applicable laws, regulations, orders, and directives. The Office is committed to delivering services with transparency and fairness to the public, while continuously improving operational performance and service quality. To achieve the objectives, Pathumthani Immigration shall undertake the following actions:

1. To administer and perform duties in accordance with the principles of good governance; to strictly oppose bribery (Anti-Bribery Policy); and to adhere to a No Gift Policy by refraining from accepting gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits. The Office shall respond to the needs of the public with honesty, integrity, fairness, transparency, and accountability at every stage.
2. To cultivate awareness, values, and attitudes among personnel in accordance with the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy, applying such principles in both official duties and daily life.
3. To encourage participation from the private sector and the public in activities related to information disclosure, through technological platforms and other appropriate forms of engagement.
4. To continuously promote campaigns for the prevention and suppression of corruption, enforcing strict and serious disciplinary measures, and to coordinate with relevant agencies to prevent and combat corruption and misconduct.
5. To promote active opposition to and surveillance against corruption in all forms, imposing the highest level of disciplinary action against involved parties in a decisive and fair manner.
